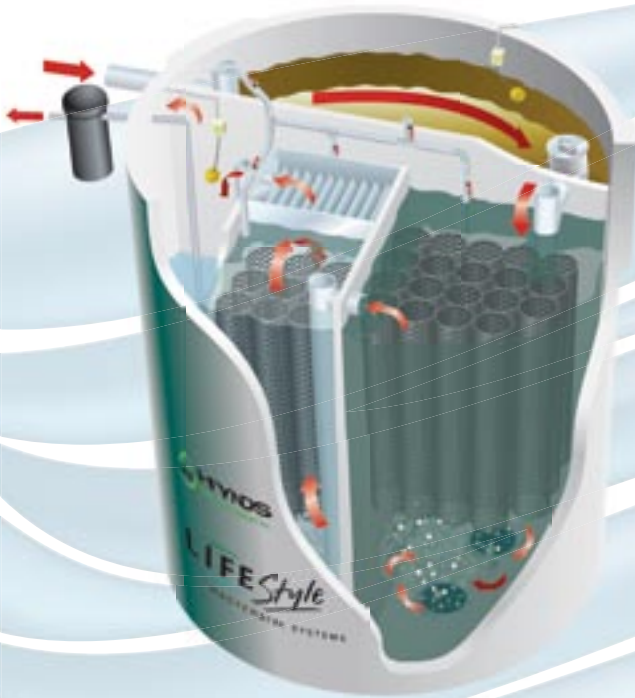

## Aerated Wastewater Treatment System

### USER GUIDE



The Hynds Lifestyle Wastewater Treatment System is an electrically powered unit that treats all household waste. The system needs to be turned on at all times.

The following information will assist in keeping the system in good health and performing efficiently.

### Product

Use environmentally friendly products such as those labeled 'septic tank friendly' or purchase economically priced purpose designed products from Ecostore (0800 335 533/www.ecostore.co.nz).

Avoid inserting the following into the system: Bleaches, strong disinfectants, milk, coffee grounds, fat, grease or oil, acids or caustics, paints, condoms, sanitary products, cigarettes, photographic chemicals and poisons.

The system performs best if the effluent load is evenly spread throughout the day.

### Tips to help the system operate effectively:

- Try not to do several loads of washing on the same day.
- Try not to do washing while people are showering.
- Try not to run the washing machine and dishwasher at the same time.

### Alarm Activation

If an alarm activates:

1. Check irrigation filter for blockage and clean if necessary (instructions below).
2. Ring Hynds Environmental immediately if the problem or alarm persists.

### Cleaning the Irrigation Filter

Find the black plastic bulb-shaped attachment (approx. 250mm long) fitted near the tank and before the irrigation.

1. Turn off the power to the system at the main switchboard.
2. Go to the Lifestyle tank and slowly remove irrigation cap (unscrew anti-clockwise). It is important to unscrew it slowly to allow any built up pressure to be relieved.
3. Remove the internal filter disc.
4. Loosen the disc by unscrewing the top off anti-clockwise.
5. Wash the disc out with a garden hose or similar. Be sure to separate the discs and clean in-between.
6. Tighten up the disc filter hand-tight. Place it back into the filter body (it will fit either way).
7. Screw up the top of the filter housing hand-tight.
8. Wash hands with anti-bacterial soap.
9. Turn the power back on.

### Maintaining the Irrigation Area

- Keep the irrigation area planted and weeded.
- Maintain bark or mulch ground cover.
- Do not cut or damage the irrigation lines.
- Keep livestock, vehicles and heavy foot traffic off this area.
- Prevent surface water flowing over this area.
